Rules: This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

Eligibility: Open to all J/22 class yachts.

Entry Fee: Fees are \$90.00, must accompany the registration form, and are not refundable. Fees include launching and haul out. Fees will be \$120.00 for all registrations received after **May 1, 2011**

Registration: Advance Registrations must be received by **May 1, 2011**. Registration limited to first 30 registration forms received.

Location: Canandaigua Yacht Club, 3524 West Lake Road, Canandaigua, NY 14424 The racing area will be on Canandaigua Lake in the area near CYC. CYC now accepts all major credit cards.

Courses: Courses will be windward/leeward, typically twice around the course.

Races: Six short races are planned, weather permitting, with additional races at the discretion of the Race Committee. One race shall constitute a series.

Scoring: When fewer than six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When more than six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

Radio Communication: The Race Committee will communicate with competitors via marine VHF radio on a channel to be announced at the Skipper's Meeting. Race Committee broadcasts concerning its intentions, count-down to starts, OCS, etc. are a only a courtesy. Failure of the Race Committee to make a broadcast or failure of a boat to hear a broadcast shall not be grounds for redress. Except in an emergency or to report retirements and protests, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. (This changes rule L 27).

Awards: Awards will be given to 1st, 2nd, & 3rd overall

Disclaimer of Liability: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. A Crew Liability Wave will need to be signed by crew. Forms will be available on our website or at check-in.

Insurance: Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$100,000 per event or the equivalent. Insurer and policy number is required on registration form.

Accommodations-

Lunch and Dinner will be available Friday through Sunday from the regular club menu.

Reservations are encouraged.

We are planning a Regatta sit down dinner (not included in Registration Fee). Information will be available during registration and will be posted on our website as soon as we have details.

The Canandaigua Yacht Club accepts Credit Cards, and will take personal checks from Regatta Participants.

Free camping and picnicking facilities are available at the club.

There are new Club rules about camping on the grounds. We will have a Fleet Representative on site. The town noise ordinance is being strictly enforced. There can be NO loud noise after 10 PM. Please be considerate of our neighbors and keep the noise down. There is also a restricted area for open fires.

Everyone Camping has to register with the CYC Manager. Please check in at the Bar.

- 1. Camping units are limited to tents, camping trailers and recreational vehicles.
- 2. **ALL CAMPERS MUST REGISTER** at the Clubhouse. Registration includes filling out the registration form, receiving a copy of the camping and swimming rules, reading the rules and signing the form agreeing to abide by these rules. (The registration information is located in the bar area.)
- 3. Camping is restricted to members, members' guests (sponsor must be camping at the same time) and regatta/event participants.
- 4. No one under 21 is permitted to camp with out an adult.
- 5. Open fires are allowed only in the two designated concrete pits. All other fires are confined to grills, camp stoves, hibachis, etc. (A fire extinguisher is near each pit and one is near the grill.)
- 6. The Town of Canandaigua **noise ordinance goes into effect at 10 p.m**. Please be courteous to our neighbors and fellow campers by refraining from loud talking, laughter, etc. after 10 p.m.
- 7. An outdoor water faucet is provided but electrical and water connections are **NOT** available.
- 8. Showers, washbasin and bathroom facilities are on the ground floor of the Clubhouse. During the season, members and guest campers have 24 hour access to this area. After 10 p.m. the noise level in these areas must also be kept to a minimum.
- 9. The camping area should be kept clean! Receptacles have been provided for this purpose.
- 10. Pets are allowed but must be kept on a leash. They should not be allowed to annoy anyone and they must be cleaned up after!
- 11. If parking near the camping area, please be careful when the ground is soggy to avoid getting stuck. Please park perpendicular to the slope to avoid a runaway car. Don't park in the sports/game area or block the entrances to the camping area itself.
